

FYI – VULCAN MEDICAL CLINIC (VMC)

INFORMATION FOR PHYSICIANS

General Information:

- You will be joining a Group Practice with 6 physicians with 4.4 FTE
- We are part of the Calgary Rural Primary Care Network
- The hospital and clinic offices are located in the Vulcan Community Health Centre
- Our physicians provide medical care for one external long-term care facility located in the Town of Vulcan and one internal long-term care facility located in the VCHC
- Electronic Medical Record – Telus Health Solutions-Wolf

Optimum number of Full-time Physicians:

- The equivalent of 4 to 5 full-time physicians is optimum at this time.
- We need locums to help cover ER shifts on weekdays. This is an opportunity for new grads to maintain hospital and ER skills.

Qualification and Experience

- Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) – required
- Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) – required
- Paediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) – desirable
- Emergency Room Training and Experience - required
- Advances in Labor and Risk Management (ALARM)– desirable
- Neonatal Resuscitation (NRP) – desirable
- Certificate of the College of Family Physicians (CCFP) – required

Clinic Hours:

- 09:00 to 12:00 and 13:00 to 17:00
- the clinic is closed from 12:00 to 1:00
- the clinic is closed on Saturdays, Sundays, and on all statutory holidays

Expected Call Schedule:

- 1 day per week, and 1 weekend per month

Clinic Statistics

- Total number of patients on the clinic's patient panel: approximately 5,000
- Average Number of Patients on an individual physician's patient panel: 700
- Average Number of patients that a physician will see on a daily basis: 20 – 30 (if on call)
